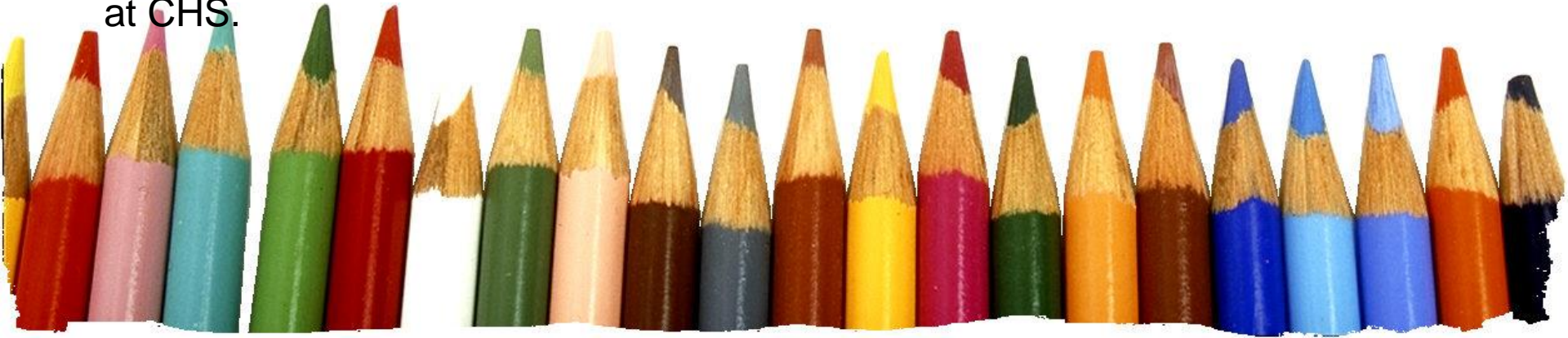


# Connersville High School
