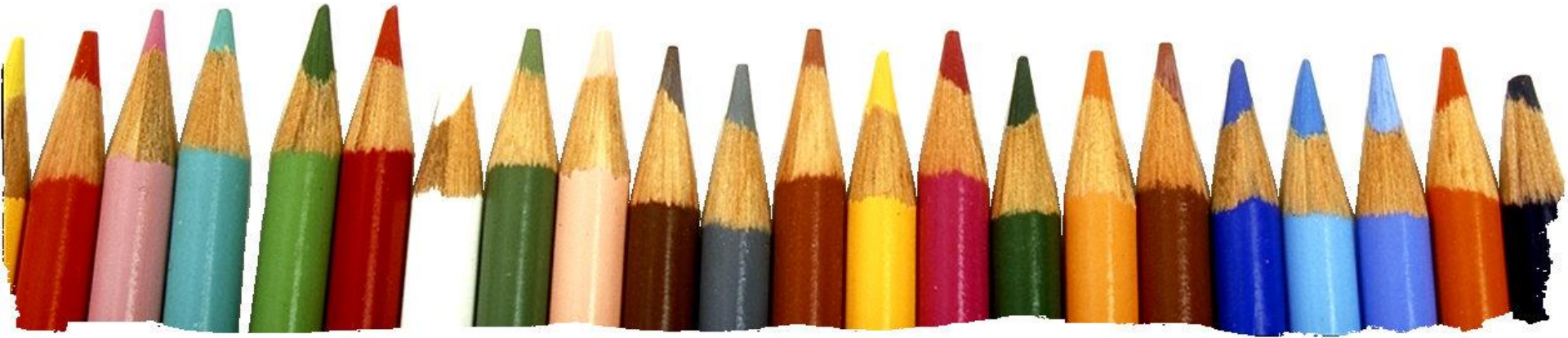


Connersville Middle School

Points of Pride 2015-2016

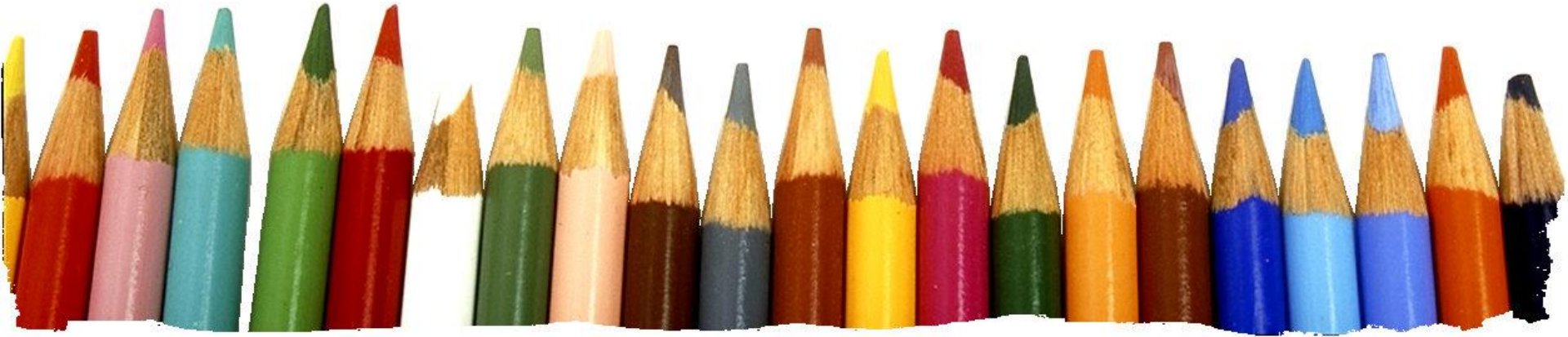
- The students and staff supported the 5th annual charity basketball game between the 8th grade girls red team and the 8th grade boys white team and raised \$2,544.00 through staff, student and community donations to the Connersville Salvation Army to support the Lord's Table.
- Students walked during their P.E./Health classes and collected an additional \$515.00 to donate to the Salvation Army.
- The CMS students raised over \$4000.00 during the 2015-16 school year that was donated to several charitable causes within the community.
- The CMS Choir performed the National Anthem at an Indiana Pacers game in November.

Points of Pride 2015-2016

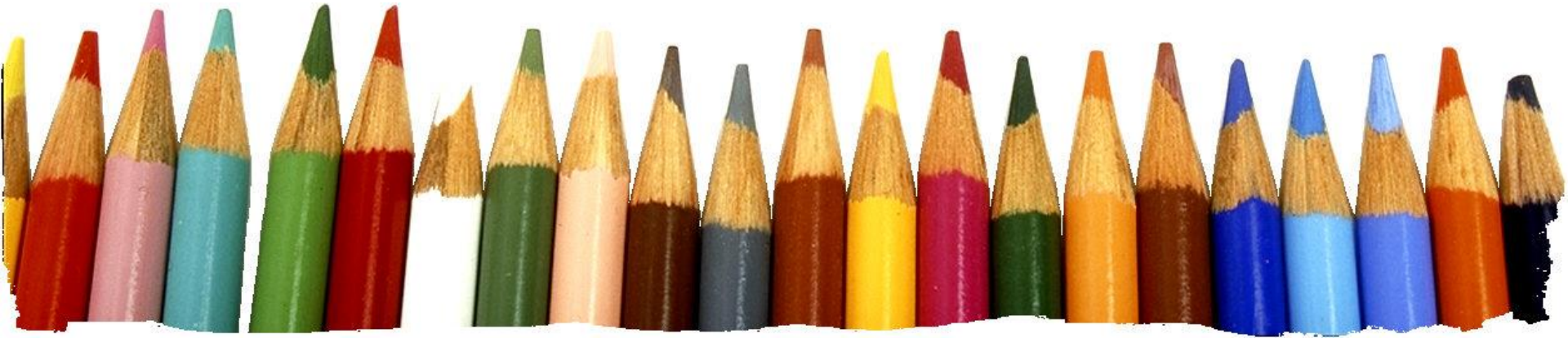
- The Male, Treble and Mixed Choirs competed at the Indiana State School Music Association in level 1 (the most difficult level for elementary/junior/middle school choirs) and all three choirs received gold ratings from all three judges.
- At the Music in the Parks competition at Kings Island, students from the combined choirs earned the highest superior rating placing first in the middle school/junior high category. The highlight of the year was the capturing of the coveted Esprit de Corps trophy – the highest award given for the second year in a row.
- The CMS band was invited to perform at the Indiana Pacers in November.
- CMS 7th Grade students participated in the Reality Store for the 24th straight year. The 7th graders get a reality-check by catching a glimpse of everyday adult responsibilities such as budgeting and paying bills.

Points of Pride 2015-2016

- A total of 100% of the 8th grade Algebra students passed the End of Course Assessment.
- In the Academic Super Bowl, the CMS Social Studies academic team placed 7th in the state overall in the Class I division and the Interdisciplinary academic team placed 6th.
- Both 7th and 8th grade students' demonstrated growth in all areas on the 2015 ISTEP+.
- The percent of students passing the 7th grade ELA section of the Spring 2015 ISTEP+ was 65.4%
- The percent of students passing the 8th grade ELA section of the Spring 2015 ISTEP+ was 68.8%.

- The percent of students passing the 8th grade Math section of the Spring ISTEP+ was 62.7%.
- The attendance rate for the 2015-16 school year increased almost one percentage point to 96.45%.
- During the 2015-16 school year, approximately 160 CMS students applied for the Early College High School program.
