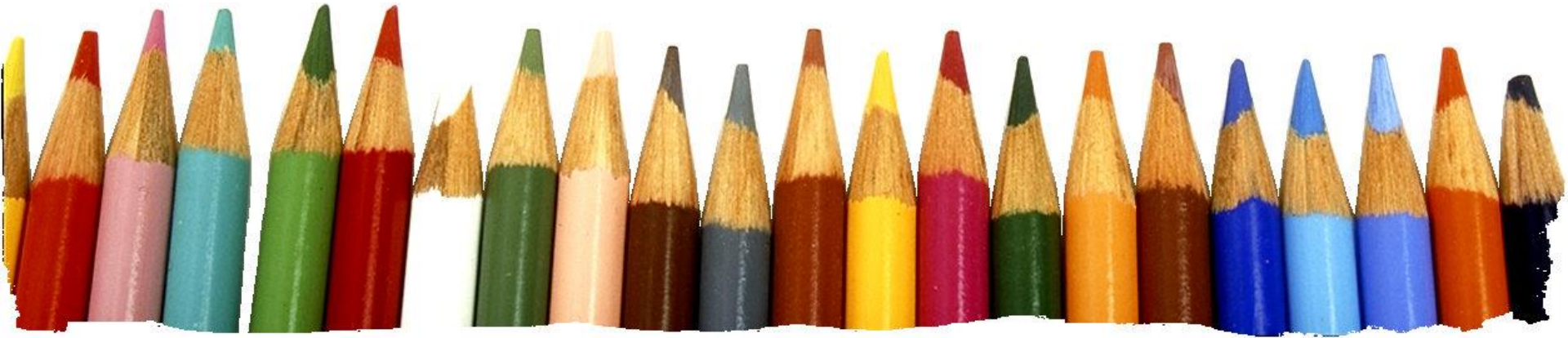


Grandview Elementary

Points of Pride 2015-2016

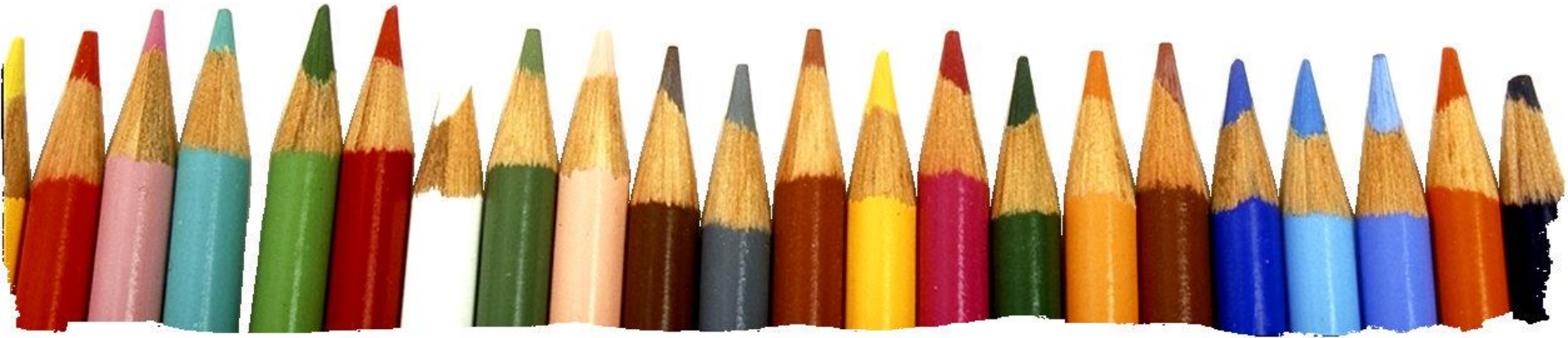
- Kyle Burkhead earned first place in physics in the 6th-8th grade division at the East Central Indiana Regional Science Fair and advanced to the state competition.
- Two of Grandview's fifth graders placed in the Daughters of the American Revolution Essay Contest: Katie Mitchell won first place and Brayden Burdoerfer earned third place.
- Grandview's 3rd and 5th grade classes presented a meaningful and memorable Veterans' Day Program in November.
- Mr. Bloom obtained a grant to purchase pickleball equipment that will enhance physical education class as well as opportunities for students outside of school.
- Third Graders researched marine animals and visited the Newport Aquarium where they observed those animals in their habitats.

Points of Pride 2015-2016

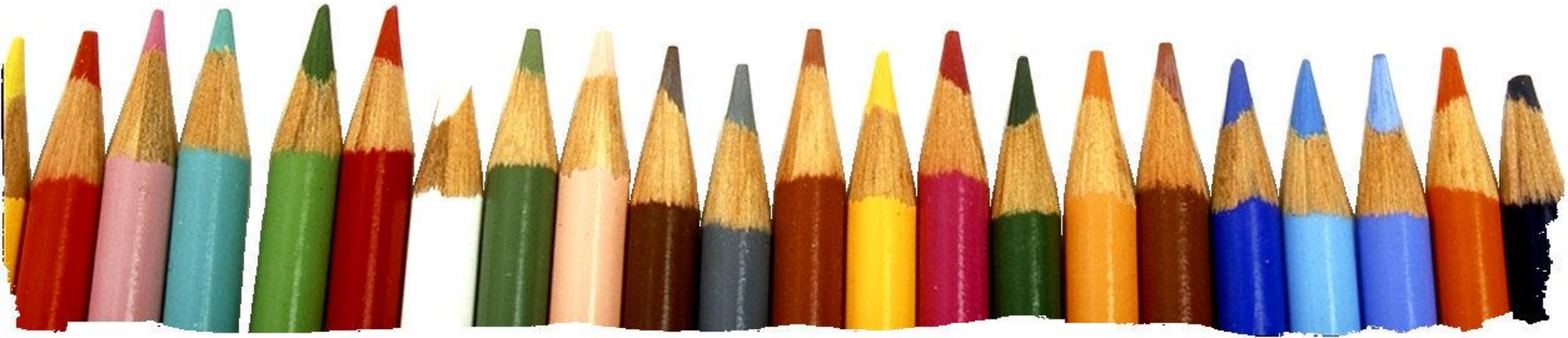
- Sixth graders collaborated with Mr. Bloom to plan and run field day.
- 72.9% of Grandview's 6th graders earned Pass or Pass+ on ELA ISTEP+ 2015, 6% above the district average.
- Grandview's mean growth percentage on ELA ISTEP+ 2015 is 57.
- Grandview's mean growth percentage on math ISTEP+ 2015 is 59.
- 100% of Mr. Crisp's sixth graders demonstrated typical or high growth on ISTEP+ in 2015.
- Grandview's rate of passing IREAD 3 in March 2016 improved 15%.
- 86% of Mrs. Branson's class demonstrated average to high growth in reading on Spring NWEA.

Points of Pride 2015-2016

- 85% of Mrs. Wagner's second graders demonstrated high growth on Spring NWEA.
- 35% of Mrs. Siggers' first graders demonstrated high growth and high achievement in math on NWEA.
- 30% of Mrs. Siggers' first graders demonstrated high growth and high achievement in reading on NWEA.
- Mrs. Tipton's fourth graders improved their math performance on Acuity. At the beginning of the year, the class was 2% below the district average. At the end of the year the class scored 3% above the district average.
- 94% of Mrs. Tipton's class scored in ranges three and four on the end of the year Acuity science assessment.

Points of Pride 2015-2016

- Two of Mrs. Coleman's fifth graders ended the year at a Z reading level.
- Six of Ms. Barrett's fifth graders ended the year reading at a level Z.
- 48% of Ms. Barrett's fifth graders improved their reading by 4 or more reading levels.
- Five of Ms. Dudley's fourth graders passed level Z in Rocket Math.
- Four first graders ended the year reading at a level M or higher.
- Two third grade students completed the Lexia program.
- 75% of Grandview's sixth graders achieved scores of 75% or higher in the Life Skills program.
- Grandview had a 96.6% attendance rate for fall conferences.
